



# Select with Peas

## Why plant a Southern Buck Food Plot?

- Easy to plant.
- Developed for the South
- Keeps your deer where you need them.
- It provides the needed protein for the proper antler and body development.
- Provides forage when natural forage is dormant.
- Good for all types of wildlife, especially deer and turkey.
- Promotes healthy wildlife.

## Planting

- Plant at a rate of 50lbs. per ½ acre.
- Drill or broadcast evenly across soil surface.
- Plant your mix ¼”- ½” deep. (Small seed should not be planted deeper than ¼”)
- Use a light drag, cultipacker or log to firm the soil after planting.

## Fertilization

- In absence of soil test, apply 350 lbs/acre of 13-13-13 and 1 ton of ag lime.
- 4-6 weeks after emergence, apply a side dress of 34-0-0 at 125-150 lbs/acre.

Southern Buck Select with Peas is a blend of Wheat, Oats, Rye and Peas. Southern Buck Select with Peas is economical and easy to plant.

## Preparation Timeline

- In late summer, spray or cut the weeds in your food plot. Also till or disk the soil, apply lime at this time.
- Mid-September thru October, till or disk the plot and drag to make smooth. Apply mixed fertilizer at this time
